What can pupil premium funding buy for your school?

ARE YOU ENTITLED TO THE PUPIL PREMIUM?

Introduced in 2011, the pupil premium fund is a sum of money given to schools each year by the Government to improve the attainment of the following children;

- Children in EYFS to Year 6 who are, or have ever been, entitled to free school meals based on their family income.
- Children in care (LAC)
- Children previously in care who have been adopted, or who have a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order.
- Children recorded as being from service families.

This gives us a great opportunity to support your child in many different ways.
